Easter Latin Mass

The traditional Latin Mass of Easter will be offered this year at Holy Ghost Church (Knoxville) at 12 noon on Easter Sunday (April 16). This special Mass will be accompanied by motets and sacred polyphony, with the variable proper parts of the great Easter liturgy sung in Gregorian chant and the fixed ordinary parts (the Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, etc.) in a choral setting by the 18th century Viennese composer Franz Joseph Haydn. All area Catholics and their friends are invited to share this festive celebration of the Resurrection of Our Lord, which in recent years has attracted Easter worshippers from a number of diocesan parishes.
